



BE PREPARED!

A wildfire can happen at any moment. Take the time to create an emergency supply kit so your family will be prepared in the event of a disaster.

Supplies can be kept in a plastic tub, small suitcase, backpack or other container. To learn what else you need in an emergency supplies kit go to readysandiego.org



EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT:

- Water- one gallon per person per day for drinking and sanitation- 3-day supply
- Ready-to-eat food, canned juices a 3-day supply
- First aid kit
- Non- prescription and prescription medication
- Mask to filter the air
- A complete change of clothing including long pants, long sleeve shirt, and sturdy shoes
- Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person
- Towel
- Personal hygiene items and feminine supplies
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification, birth certificates and marriage licenses
- Mobile device and extra chargers
- Infant formula and diapers
- Pet food, water and supplies for your pet (separate checklist available)
- Cash and change
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates, disposable utensils, and paper towels
- Paper and pencil
- Local maps
- Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children
- Flashlight and extra batteries
